Purpose

Values & Goals

Relationships

While prayer and discussion of curriculum are key elements of a life group, the driving force behind the group is the building of relationships.

Authenticity

The atmosphere of a life group should encourage openness and transparency among members. This is an environment where people should feel free to be themselves.

Confidentiality

For authenticity to occur, members must be able to trust that issues discussed within a life group will not be shared outside the group.

Respect

Group members should never say anything that will embarrass their spouse or members of the group.

Availability

A primary responsibility of community is to prioritize for specific relationships. This requires a willingness to be available to meet each other's needs.

Multiplication

Group members recognize that one of the goals of their group is to start a new group within twenty-four to thirty-six months. This allows others to experience the life group relationship.
